4. Consider Approval of the July 21, 2021 Meeting Minutes

It was moved by Director Stretch, seconded by Alternate Director Jimenez, and carried that the minutes of the July 21, 2021, Board of Directors meeting be approved as presented. Alternate Director Armendariz and Alternate Director Merritt abstained.

6. Advisory Committee Report

Chair Fast called on Advisory Committee Chair Jim Maciel to provide a report on Advisory Committee activities on September 16, 2021. Maciel reported that the Advisory Committee received staff reports and made a recommendation to the Board of Directors to consider the addition of the Sultana Community Services District's Distribution Replacement Project to the IRWMP project list.

7. Staff Reports

A. Planning and Implementation Contracts – Soua Lee provided an update on the status of Proposition 1, Round 1 IRWM Implementation Grant and Proposition 1 DAC Involvement Grant. Regarding the upcoming Proposition 1 Round 2 IRWM Implementation grant solicitation, Lee reported that IRWM Funding Areas are to select one of two application deadlines proposed by DWR. The two proposed application deadlines are March 2022 and September 2022. The Board discussed this matter and provided direction to staff to notify the IRWM regions in the Tulare-Kern Funding Area that the KBWA's preference is the March 2022 application deadline. Lee noted that the Funding Area would need to provide consensus on one application submittal date and potentially the preferred March 2022 date may not be the selected date.

- *B. Inter-regional and Statewide Coordination* Lee reported that the IRWM Roundtable of Regions is planning a 2021 Roundtable of Regions Summit for November 15 -17. The summit will be a three half-day virtual event focused on IRWM and climate change. Summit registration link was previously forwarded to Members and Interested Parties.

- E. Administrative Items Lee noted that the 2022 meeting dates of the KBWA Advisory Committee and Board of Directors is included in the agenda packet. It was requested that staff send Board Directors the 2022 meeting calendar invites.
- *F. Other* None to report.
- 8. Request to Authorization to Prepare and Submit Documents Necessary to Request Funding from DWR's 2021 Urban and Multi-benefit Drought Relief Grant Program to Supplement the Prop 1 Disadvantaged Community Involvement Program

Lee reported that the County of Tulare on behalf of the Tulare-Kern Funding Area is planning to apply to DWR's 2021 Urban and Multi-benefit Drought Relief Grant Program for up to \$5M to supplement the existing Prop 1 DAC Involvement Grant Program. This funding would be used to implement several DAC drought planning projects developed under the Prop 1 DAC Involvement

Grant Program. Specific to the KBWA, a portion of this funding, if awarded, may be allocated to implement Malaga County Water District's project to construct a new community water supply well. The County of Tulare will require letters of support from each IRWM region in the Tulare-Kern Funding Area for inclusion in the grant application. It was moved by Director Valero, seconded by Director Cameron, and unanimously carried that staff prepare and submit the necessary documents to the County of Tulare for inclusion in the grant application to the 2021 Urban and Multi-benefit Drought Relief Grant Program.

9. Request to Modify the IRWM Plan Project List

Lee reported that the Advisory Committee provided a recommendation to the Board to include the Sultana Community Services District's Distribution Replacement Project to the IRWM Plan project list. The goal of this project is to replace leaky potable pipes in the community with new ones to reduce loss of potable water supply during distribution. It was moved by Director Valero, seconded by Alternate Director Jimenez, and unanimously carried that Sultana Community Services District's project be added to the IRWM Plan project list.

10. Request to Approve Quarterly Financial Reports

Brain Trevarrow provided an overview of the quarterly financial reports for the period July 1, 2021 – September 30, 2021. It was moved by Alternate Director Merritt, seconded by Director Valero, and unanimously carried that the quarterly financial reports be approved as presented.

The next regularly scheduled meeting for the Board of Directors is April 20, 2022, at 9:30 a.m. at the Fresno County Farm Bureau.
