4. Approval of the March 16, 2022 Meeting Minutes

Staff noted an edit to the minutes to show that Roy Jimenez represented the County of Fresno at the March 16, 2022 Advisory Committee meeting. It was moved by Alternate Director Merritt, seconded by Director Cameron, and carried that the minutes of the March 16, 2022 meeting of the Advisory Committee be approved with an edit to the County of Fresno representative. Alternate Director Sunamoto abstained.

5. Staff Reports

A. Planning and Implementation Contracts – Soua Lee referred to the grant matrix in the agenda packet and reported on the Proposition 1 Round 1 IRWM Implementation Grant and Proposition 1 Disadvantaged Community Involvement Grant (Prop 1 DACI).

B. Inter-regional and Statewide Coordination – Lee reported that the IRWM Roundtable of Regions is in the process of contracting with a new Network Coordinator. Lee notes that her term expired on the Steering Committee of the Roundtable, but that she will continue as chair for the Roundtable's DAC and Tribal Involvement Workgroup. The purpose of the workgroup is to share grant and best practice information that DACs and Tribal groups can use to access resources.

C. Public Information – Vice Chair Stretch called on Debra Dunn with Kings River Conservation District to provide an update on the Kings Water Alliance (KWA) group. Dunn shared updates on the current work of the KWA. The KWA serves as the Management Zone for the Kings and Tulare Lake groundwater subbasins and its purpose is to implement new water quality requirements under the Salt and Nitrate Control Program by the State Water Resources Control Board.

D. Legislation – None to report.

E. Administrative Items – Lee shared that due to health concerns, Chair Maciel is stepping down as Chair of the Advisory Committee effective immediately. The Advisory Committee will nominate a new chair at the September meeting of the Advisory Committee.

F. Other – None to report.

6. Request to Modify the Kings Basin IRWM Plan Project List

Lee reported that Bakman Water Company (BWC) submitted a new project to the IRWMP project list. BWC's project is also a project that was reviewed and vetted by the Project Review Panel to move forward in the Prop 1 Round 2 IRWM Implementation grant solicitation. The project proposes to install nitrate analyzers on their wells to monitor nitrate levels at each well. It was moved by Director Cameron, seconded by Alternate Director Merritt, and unanimously carried that a recommendation be made to the Board of Directors to add BWC's project to the IRWMP project list.

7. Recommendation t Approve Projects for Inclusion in an Application for a Grant Under the DWR Proposition 1 Round 2 IRWM Implementation Grant Solicitation

Lee referred to a handout that was given to the Advisory Committee at the beginning of the meeting. The handout provided an overview of the three projects that the Project Review Panel reviewed and recommended to move forward in the Prop 1 Round 2 IRWM Implementation grant solicitation. It was moved by Alternate Director England, seconded by Alternate Director Jimenez, and unanimously carried that a recommendation be made to the Board of Directors to approve the Fresno Irrigation

District's project, City of Parlier's project, and Bakman Water Company's project in an application to DWR for Prop 1 Round 2 IRWM Implementation Grant funds.
