A. *Planning and Implementation Contracts* – Soua Lee referred to the grants matrix in the agenda packet and reported on the status of the Proposition 1 Round 1 and Round 2 IRWM Implementation Grants. Under the Round 1 funding, Fresno Metropolitan Flood Control District's project resumed work on August 24, 2023 and installation of the pump station deep shafts is in progress. Delivery of the pumps and electrical components are delayed. Under the Round 2 funding, the Fresno Irrigation District Recharge Basin Project has completed CEQA and is continuing with permitting and final design.

B. Inter-regional and Statewide Coordination – Lee reported that there will be a 2023 California Water Plan Update Plenary in Roseville on October 3 and 4 and will feature the premier of the 20th IRWM Anniversary film. Lee noted that she will be at the Plenary and was invited to speak on the work and accomplishments of the KBWA.

D. Legislation – Lee reported that there are no changes to the status of AB 1567 (Garcia) and SB 867 (Allen).

E. Administrative Items – Lee provided a reminder that new directors or representatives appointed to the KBWA should be communicated to Lee so that the roster can be updated.
